ASERF Grant \$50,000 for the analysis of components and viability of the levels of centrifuged fat

Just finished using the murine animal model to study the effect of human fat grafts on acute burn wounds.

Armed Forces Institute of Regenerative Medicine Biomedical Translational Initiative with Peter Rubin at UPMC

- Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs Funded \$1.6 million to investigate the use of fat grafting in facial and cranial war casualties in 20 soldiers
- About to start next research project using stem cell enriched fat grafts on war casualties in soldier.
