

Alfonso Fausto, MD

He was born in Milan, Italy in September 23th, 1969. After secondary school certification focusing on sciences, he attended the University of Milan School of Medicine. In 1994 he graduated with the thesis: "Comparative study of antioxidant biochemical asset during normal and complicated pregnancies by severe preclampsia". In 1998 he obtained the postgraduate degree in General Medicine and in 2006 in Radiology with the thesis: "Magnetic resonance spectroscopy of breast cancers: in vivo study at 1.5 Tesla and ex vivo study at 9.4 Tesla".

He worked as medical doctor in Air Force "G. Vassura" of Rimini (RN) and in the Istituto Geriatrico Milanese (Milan). He worked as radiologist in the University Hospital of San Donato Milanese, University of Milan School of Medicine, in which he was consultant for breast imaging, Regional Breast Screening Program focusing on MR and interventional procedures and deepening his experience at San Giovanni di Dio General Hospital of Gorizia. Nowadays he works at the University Department of Radiology, Azienda Ospedaliera Universitaria Senese, Siena (Italy).

He was an invited speaker and discussant in the University of Milan School of Medicine (Italy), Roma "La Sapienza" (Italy), Torino (Italy), Ancona (Italy), Varese (Italy), Jena (Germany), Copenhagen (Denmark) and Sao Paulo (SP, Brazil).

European Congress of Radiology awarded him in 2004, the Italian Society of Medical Radiology in 2004 and he received the Research & Education Fund Grant of ECR in 2005. He has published 23 scientific papers with impact factor (IF=50.471), 11 scientific papers without IF, 5 case reports on EURORAD and 2 chapters in scientific books.

Radiologic research topics are: breast imaging and interventional procedures; bone densitometry in AIDS; ultrasound-guided procedure for regional anesthesia and pain treatment; multiple sclerosis in MR imaging.
